

General Terms and Conditions

- This competition is open to New Zealand secondary school students enrolled in Years 10 – 13 in New Zealand secondary schools and kura kaupapa Māori, including international students.
- The International Ultimate Concept Artist Award & International Rising Stars Highly Commended Awards are open to students aged 14–18 from anywhere in the world excluding New Zealand domestic students.
- Entries open at 3pm on Monday 19 April 2021
- Entries close at 3pm on Wednesday 1 July 2021. Late entries will not be accepted.

- Entries must be submitted online at <u>creative.massey.ac.nz/</u>
 <u>earthguardians</u>
- Characters can be created in any media including, but not limited to, digital images, scanned drawings, paintings or high-quality photographs of 3D models.
- Digital images should be high resolution 1080x1080px and scanned images should be at 300dpi.
- Entry submissions must include:
- Name of your character
- A 300 word description of the inspiration behind your design. Each individual may submit a maximum of 2 entries, which must
- be 2 different characters.
 Entries much be your own original idea and not a copy of anyong
- Entries must be your own original idea and not a copy of anyone else's work.
- Finalists will be announced online at <u>creative.massey.ac.nz/</u> <u>earthguardians</u> on **Friday 13 August 2021**.
- The ten winners of the Weta Workshop New Zealand Rising Stars Highly Commended Awards will be chosen online by public vote from the 20 finalists selected by our panel of industry judges.
- All travel prizes are up to the value of \$150. Any additional travel costs, accommodation or travel for caregivers of winners under the age of 16 is at the cost of the recipient.
- Winners must consent to images of their work and photographs of their experiences being used in marketing and social media by both Massey University and our partner sponsors.
- Prizes involving a trip to Wellington including New Zealand Ultimate Concept Artist Award, New Zealand Rising Stars Highly Commended Awards, Moana Ocean Narratives Award, Te Ao Māori Award are subject to the Wellington region and the prize winners' region being in New Zealand Government Covid-19 Alert Level 1 or 2 at the date of the visit (October 2021 school holidays). If the trip cannot take place or an individual cannot attend due to Covid-19 or any other reason, the monetary value of the prize (\$150) will be awarded instead.

Weta Workshop New Zealand Ultimate Concept Artist Award

Weta Workshop New Zealand Rising Stars Highly Commended Awards x10

\$150 towards travel to Wellington for a masterclass in Concept Design and a tour of Weta Workshop

A shortlist of the top 20 submissions will be made by industry judges <u>Paul Tobin</u>, Art Director at Weta Workshop and <u>Tanya Marriott</u>, programme leader of Concept Design at the Massey University, Ngā Pae Māhutonga Wellington School of Design.

These 20 finalists will be announced online at <u>creative.massey.ac.nz/</u> <u>earthguardians</u> for a one-week online voting period.

The top 10 finalists as picked by the public will receive \$150 towards travel to attend the Weta Workshop experience in the October school holidays.

Any additional travel expenses above \$150 is at the expense of the winner.

Winners under the age of 16 as of 26 September 2021 will be required to have a caregiver with them for the duration of the trip. Travel for the caregiver is not included in this prize.

International Ultimate Concept Artist Award

Any student, non-resident or domestic, studying at a New Zealand secondary school will be considered for categories open to New Zealand students.

Delivery of this prize will be arranged with the winner.

If you are an International student studying at a New Zealand secondary school your entry will be considered for categories open to New Zealand students.

Wellington School of Design Create With Us Award

\$1000 towards studying for the Bachelor of Design with Honours at Massey University

This award will be judged by Design Kaihāpai Astrid Visser, and Claire Hackett, Senior Tutor, Concept Design, Massey University.

To be eligible for this award, entrants must be intending to study at Massey University, Ngā Pae Māhutonga Wellington School of Design in 2022 or 2023, and will need to enrol in their programme of choice by 1 October 2021. This award will be paid out to the winner's nominated bank account after the withdrawal date for your programme.

Winners must enrol in the Bachelor of Design with Honours degree and select from the following majors: Integrated Design, Concept Design, Spatial Design, Visual Communication Design, Textile Design, Fashion Design, or Industrial Design. Please note the Photography major is not included.

Entry to these programmes are subject to portfolio review and the successful completion of University Entrance through NCEA or equivalent. Applicants must meet the full requirements for entry for the Bachelor of Design with Honours. Receiving this award does not guarantee you a place in your programme of choice.

It is expected that entrants for this award will be in Year 12, or Year 13.

If the recipient of this award does not meet the requirements for entry, or chooses to not enrol in the Bachelor of Design with Honours, then this award will be in name only.

Massey University Moana Oceania Narratives Award

\$500 prize pack including flights to Wellington for a Weta Workshop experience

This award will be judged by Sonya Withers, Lecturer at Massey University, Ngā Pae Māhutonga, Wellington School of Design.

This award will be made to the best entry that displays homage to Atua across Te Moana-nui-a-Kiwa.

This award is only open to students of Pacific identity or heritage.

The winner will take part in the Weta Workshop experience which will happen in the October school holidays 2021.

Winners under the age of 16 as of 26 September 2021 will be required to have a caregiver with them for the duration of the trip. Travel for the caregiver is not included in this prize.

Massey University Te Ao Māori Award

\$500 prize pack including flights to Wellington for a Weta Workshop experience

This award is only open to Māori students.
