### Course overview

This is the landing page for course selections.

This timetable shows every option for your classes. Don't be alarmed: in practice, you will be in class for about 12 hours per week. The rest of the time is yours for independent study.



**Do not** try to book your class times through the link here or the Massey app.

For Fine Arts, you are timetabled in Stream, Massey's online learning environment.

- Core studios: Classes will be either Mondays and Thursdays, 9am to 12noon, or Tuesdays and Fridays, 9am to 12noon. We allocate you to a group and post that on Stream.
- Makers in Context: Tutorials are weekly in the afternoon. You will select your day and time in Stream.
- **Electives:** Classes are weekly; most are in the afternoon.

Keep an eye on your inbox in the Student Portal for messages about sign-ups in Stream.

If you are concerned about your timetable, come and see us during Orientation and we will sort you out.

Once you select your courses, this warning will disappear.


