2.	Provide an example of a past creative work, including a summary of what it is, your motivation, how it was produced, and its connection to other creative works or literature. Please upload the work separately in the portal. (Max 400-500 words.)

3.	(Master of Design Applicants Only): please identify a specific topic area that is a current social, cultural, or environmental issue for which you could make a positive impact through your design process. Max 200-300 words.
4.	Please indicate below if you have used any AI tools in your submission and specify the aspects of your work where they were applied.

- A digital portfolio of relevant creative work in PDF format (up to 20 pages). You may include live links to online repositories for audio and video content
- An academic transcript
- A CV (including relevant professional experience)
